Preface

Fire risk, sudden flash floods, extreme heat, extreme cold, extreme blizzards.

Just a few of the things that mean that people need to be more aware and more prepared with their homes and their families and everything else they have that matters to them and others.

Add in basic health and safety about food supply and care, hygiene, viruses.

Add in the fact that the internet is fine but besides the complexities of what's right and what's wrong, there can be down-times, especially when there are bad storms or other severe situations.

People need to know more and better for their own safety, health, well-being and happiness.

Especially folks who may have moved into a new area like Montana and need to adjust to basics about mountains, climate, and everything else in their environment.

Home Safe Ed is a program designed by a unique team of experienced mentors and intelligent youth - children in middle and high school and older ages - who want to do something for giving better resources, guidance and assistance to their families, neighbors and communities. They do everything on a volunteer basis, organized, coordinated, mentored by elders from their families and throughout the community. That includes volunteer teachers, professors, doctors, police, firefighters, veterans, and many others.

Home Safe Ed is absolutely not only something “online”. It definitely has all that, with a big emphasis on easy-to-understand videos, comics, things to appeal to people from every age, from pre-school on up to post-retirement. But besides what exists in media – text, pictures, videos – there is live-team help that can bring real physical assistance – know-how and muscle-power – by energetic, trained, skilled young men and women – to families and homesteads in need. Sometimes people want to do things to change and improve their lives, including things in and around the home, but it just isn't

quite possible due to any of a number of situations. That is where sometimes Home Safe Ed folks can put in a helping hand – or actually, more like 6 or 8 or 12 helping hands – on an afternoon or a weekend, and get a lot of valuable things done around someone's home. Things that can be a life-saver and a property-saver for those folks and their neighbors, in the event of something like a forest fire or a flood.

Some Home Safe Ed Inspirations, Principles, Guidances

Home Safe Ed is based upon about 50,000 years of human history and experience living on Planet Earth under sometimes very challenging and near-catastrophic conditions. Montana is a perfect example of the positive results of this big Learning Experience. People came here tens of thousands of years ago, originally from deep in Asia. Others came from the other direction much later on.

Home Safe Ed draws upon and builds upon our combined cultural histories – Native American and farther-back ancestors, and all newcomers to North America and the Region.

Everything is Free to the recipients. This is about community responsibility and that includes corporate responsibility.

People come to us, they find out about us, they get information online, they ask for more including interaction, maybe visits and physical onsite assistance.

We approach people, but through different agencies and departments that make suggestions (e.g., someone in social services, or fire, police, or EMS, say to us, “These folks, we've talked with them, and you Home Safe Ed people could help them, and they are interested and willing to learn more.”)

The Five “S” Principles – Safety, Security, Sensibility, Sustainability, Service (to others)

How we do things

We use visuals – graphics, videos, and even cartoons.

We use our voices and we demonstrate and show.

We don't just talk and show, we Do. In cases of special need, we come over and use hammers, saws, shovels, rakes and more.

The Major Themes and Topics – What We Do for People

§ Information and education (thus, “Home Safe Ed”) about:

- stable construction for houses and other buildings
- stable sensible ways to move and rearrange the earth, the land, around a home
- preparing for and minimizing the risks from fire, flood, and other natural disasters
- safety to avoid accidents from Nature (e.g., lightning, falling trees) or human activities in and around the home
- avoiding biohazards around and inside the home, including pests, invasive species, and microbes like bacteria and viruses
- proper handling and storage of machines, appliances, weapons, household items
- sensible activities and stress-reducers in events of problems from the environment or any other type

§ Doing – making and building things for some people at their homes, when they really need help and can't do it for themselves

We have special heroes and heroines

They're more down to earth than Superman or Captain Marvel and they are all designed and crafted, by the way, by Kids who like to do such art on their computers and on traditional paper and canvas!

Who are these Youth who are in Home Safe Ed?

All types, all demographics, all backgrounds. We particularly aim to draw into the team youth who have for whatever reasons become “sick and tired” with their usual life, maybe with school and academic subjects. Home Safe Ed offers an Alternative to the regular process, which simply does not appeal to everyone. Some children feel better measuring out a 2-6 with a measuring tape and making a fine cut with a saw, rather than doing maths and chemistry in a classroom. Some young people want to be Outdoors, not Indoors, as much as possible. Some guys and girls want to see something cool and new at the end of the day and say, “See! We built this today!” rather than to write and hand in a 10-page paper. Some kids have dropped out and given up and turned to the lowest-common-denominator in life, often with alcohol, drugs, and anti-social, anti-self-respect lifestyles, with crime and violence mixed in. Our door is very Open to these guys and girls because they have something in them that is called Life Energy and they know that they want to Turn It On in a way that feels good at the end of the day.

Our “SWOT” Approach

We consider your home, your land, from the perspective of “S-W-O-T” - this comes from the business

and finance world, it is a way of analyzing companies, projects, enterprises:
Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, Threats

We apply traditional, proven business and finance methods in regard to the home, the land, everything there, being and staying safe from fire, flood, other natural disasters, or pollution, or pest-infestation, or infection, or intrusive wild animals, etc. We look at all the situations, the possibilities, the risks and hazards, and we suggest ways to “strengthen your Strengths and Opportunities” (for good, sensible, pleasurable, even profitable uses) and to “reduce your Weaknesses and Threats” (from all the things that can go wrong).

We focus on the basic and major physics things, but we also examine what we call the “CBRNE” space of home safety – Chemical, Biological, Radioactive-Nuclear, and Explosive. Sure, these threats and risks are very low, thankfully, usually, but if people store and use certain chemicals and other substances too close together, well, it can be a bad situation almost anywhere, anytime, and in some cases, extremely dangerous, but also simple to solve!

Our Emphasis Points:

§ The advantage of easy to get, easy to use information through the internet-of-things Combined With Personal actions, whether that is to meet and just talk and explain, or to come over and Do something physically, in special circumstances, when people are really In Need and cannot do things for themselves, physically or financially.

§ The Opportunities for People:

- What You (owner, resident) Can Do
- What We (Home Safe Ed team) can Do to help You
- How We can help You get help and support
- How You can get things that are easier to access and more available than you may imagine
- How We can all live safer and more happily as a Community in Montana!
